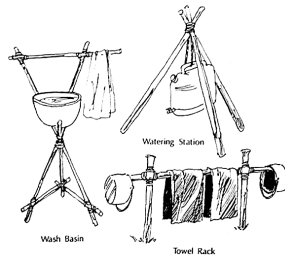
Cub Scout Family Camp at Camp Roland **5/20**
